Anti-epidemic Measures for Inter-school Sports Competitions / Events in 2021-2022 Anti-epidemic

Measures and arrangements for inter-school sports competitions / events organized by the Federation are as follows:

1. According to the guidelines of the Education Bureau (EDB), during the period of face-to-face classes, schools may arrange primary and secondary students having received two doses of COVID-19 vaccines for more than 14 days to participate in extra-curricular sports activities. For calculation of number of vaccine dosage, please refer to “Prevention of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Health Protection Measures for Schools” issued by the EDB.

2. Schools must comply with the latest requirements of the aforesaid “Health Protection Measures for Schools”. In addition, schools should pay attention to the latest arrangements for “Vaccine Pass” of various premises, and strictly comply with the guidelines and requirements of the premises. Moreover, schools should strictly observe the anti-epidemic measures including wearing of masks before and after physical activities, maintaining appropriate social distances and performing hand hygiene properly.

3. For competitions / events held at schools, “Vaccine Pass” arrangements are not applicable to a school’s own students; Students (as visitors) from other schools participating in school activities (including inter-school competitions) will be exempted from the requirements of “Vaccine Pass”.

4. All participants except students (including but not limited to teacher / non-staff team managers, referees and officials) who hold a “COVID-19 Medical Exemption Certificate” must present a negative COVID-19 test result# proof conducted within 7 days* (calculated from the date of testing). Such arrangements have made reference to the EDB guidelines on vaccine pass arrangement for all school staff or relevant persons. # The specimens must be collected by combined nasal and throat swabs, but not by self-testing kits. The testing results of the deep throat saliva test or Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) are not accepted. Updated on 18 May 2022

5. All participants are required to undergo and complete Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) on the same day and before attending the competition / event. Participants are only allowed to attend the competition / event after obtaining negative test results and to declare such on the “Health Declaration Form”.

6. All participating schools and participants are required to submit the “Health Declaration Form” on each competition / event day and to observe the anti-epidemic measures and special arrangements of respective competitions / events. Information provided will be used for the purpose of preventing the occurrence or spread of infectious disease or contamination, all health declaration forms will be destroyed within 3 months after the competition / event.

7. Any person subject to mandatory quarantine (including StayHomeSafe Scheme or home isolation) as required by the government, or school that is suspending face-to-face classes or classes are (partially or fully) suspended in light of the epidemic will not be allowed to participate in inter-school sports competitions/events. Person with symptoms of COVID-19, such as fever, respiratory symptoms or sudden loss or taste or smell should refrain from attending the competition / event and seek medical advice promptly.

8. Schools are responsible to monitor and ensure that their participants comply with the anti-epidemic measures and arrangements of the Federation. If any participant is being informed to be a confirmed case, or a close contact of a confirmed case of COVID-19, schools must contact staff of the Federation as soon as possible:
