# <u>Citizenship and Social Development Mainland Study Tour</u> <u>For Form 4 and Form 5 Students</u>

Dear Parents,

In order to allow all high school students to participate in field trips and gain an understanding of the country's situation and latest developments, the Education Bureau has placed a priority for senior form students to participate in the "Citizenship and Social Development Mainland Study Tour." The Education Bureau will fully subsidize the group expenses for teachers and students, including visit activities, meals, accommodation, transportation, and basic group comprehensive travel insurance.

Similar to the arrangements for student exchange programs with the mainland, if any student requests to withdraw before departure, the withdrawing student will be required to pay additional expenses incurred due to the withdrawal. The Education Bureau may also revoke the subsidy for that student, and the student will be responsible for paying the related tour fees and additional withdrawal fees. Only under special circumstances, such as students falling ill (with a medical certificate as proof) or being unable to depart with the group due to other significant accidents, will the Education Bureau consider not revoking the subsidy for that student.

This mainland study tour is an important component of the Civic Education curriculum. It is designed to actively promote and guide students in learning and understanding the learning objectives of Civic Education, deepen their understanding of national development, broaden their horizons, cultivate their ability to think from multiple perspectives and critically analyze information, and develop their collaborative, communicative, and investigative skills, among other general abilities. Students are expected to participate as much as possible. Therefore, participants must attend the pre-departure briefing session regarding the exchange itinerary. After returning, students are required to conduct research and reflection based on their study tour experience and submit reports to the school in their individual capacity.

To ensure the smooth progress of the mainland study tour, the school reminds parents to check the validity of their students' Hong Kong and Macau residents' Mainland Travel Permits (Home Return Permits). If the permits have expired or are about to expire, please make an appointment as soon as possible to apply for new permits and submit a copy of the valid Home Return Permit to the school by **March 20th**. If there are difficulties in the application process or if permits cannot be obtained on time, please promptly notify the teacher in charge of the Civic and Social Development Studies subject. For students holding foreign passports, please provide a photocopy of the passport to the teacher in charge of the subject by **March 20th** to prepare for the visa application to enter the mainland. Subsequently, other relevant documents will also need to be submitted for the visa application.

As all high school students in Hong Kong have the opportunity to participate in the "Citizenship and Social Development Mainland Study Tour," it is anticipated that there will be a high demand for Home Return Permits. Parents and students are advised to allocate sufficient time for the application process. If you have any inquiries, please contact **Mr. Ng Wang Sung** and **Mr. Leung Chung Hong** at the school.

We kindly request parents' attention and cooperation to ensure the smooth progress of the mainland study tour.
