Experience thrills at NEW Shinhwa Theme Park – ride roller coasters and dive into immersive themed zones! Shop at vibrant markets, try street food, and capture Instagramworthy shots at Seongsan Sunrise Peak. Jeju blends natural beauty with non-stop fun. This Jeju tour transforms English and Maths into realworld tools. Students analyze coastal data, and communicate in English to locals—turning the island into a dynamic classroom.	This Tour explores Italy and Vatican City on an 8- to 10-day journey through history, art, and culture. The itinerary features the majestic ruins of Ancient Rome, the enchanting landscapes of Civita di Bagnoregio, the medieval charm of Perugia, and Assisi— the hometown of Saint Francis. You will also visit Vatican City to behold the artistic masterpieces of the Sistine Chapel, continue to Florence to experience the spirit of the Renaissance, and conclude in Milan, immersing yourself in its vibrant fashion and design scene. This journey offers a profound appreciation of Italy's rich cultural heritage and artistic legacy.	This tour brings STEAM to life in Kyoto and Osaka. Students will explore the mathematical precision of Japanese architecture, from Osaka Castle's geometry to Fushimi Inari's sequential torii gates. They'll engage in hands-on workshops—coding robotics, analyzing urban design, and creating digital art inspired by traditional patterns. Through English- language activities and collaboration with local students, participants will develop critical thinking and innovation skills while discovering how mathematics and technology shape Japan's unique cultural landscape.
